After 21 days, patients should consult a physician

Patients should use Voltaren 4 times a day, every day Do not use on more than 2 body areas at the same time

Patients should use the supplied dosing card to measure a dose:

- For each upper body area (hand, wrist, or elbow) squeeze out 2.25 inches (2 grams)
 - For each lower body area (foot, ankle, or knee) squeeze out 4.5 inches (4 grams)

The American College of Rheumatology strongly recommends topical NSAIDs, like Voltaren®, as a first-line treatment of osteoarthritis pain
