

DENTIN HYPERSENSITIVITY DIAGNOSIS PROTOCOL

A few simple questions can lead to much-needed relief.

PATIENT HISTORY

Does the patient suffer from dentin hypersensitivity?

ASK



- Are you still experiencing sensitivity?
- Are you still using your sensitivity toothpaste?
- Do you have any pain when eating or drinking something hot or cold?
- When brushing, do you avoid certain areas of your mouth due to sensitivity?



DURING THE VISIT

CLINICAL ASSESSMENT

- Pain from the cold due to air/water syringe?
- Need for a topical anesthetic?
- Non-clinical carious lesions?
- Tactile or chemical sensitivity?
- Other sensitivity causes?

- Is the patient undergoing or planning a whitening treatment?

stannous fluoride formula



RECOMMEND SENSODYNE CLINICAL REPAIR FOR SENSITIVITY PATIENTS

- Initiate the regimen
- Hand the patient a sample, if available, and recommend they start brushing today
- Remind patients to use twice daily and **3 days prior to a dental visit**

potassium nitrate formula

NEXT VISIT

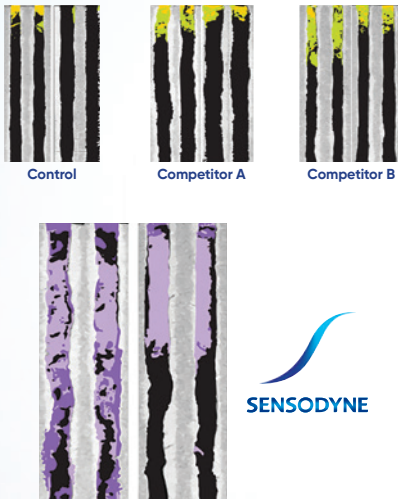

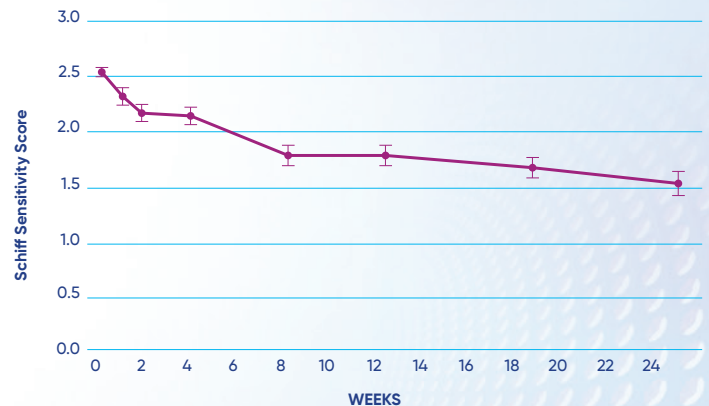
